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80 Block - Half Square Triangle Pattern by Sheilah Zielinski 2017

Finished block size: (with 1/4" seam allowance) 61/2" x 61/2"

Finished top size:

Eight blocks horizontal x Ten blocks vertically: approx.48" x 60".

Binding: 21/2" wide

Fabric Requirements & Cutting Instructions:

11/4 yard dark fabric; 11/4 yard light fabric

Kit includes:


(40) 6½" squares – light fabric (A in Fig.1)

(40) 6½" squares – dark fabric (see edge of B in Fig 1)



Assembly:

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of the light fabric.
- 2. Match with another (dark) square, right sides together (Fig. 1).
- 3. Sew a scant ¼" seam on each side of the drawn line (Fig. 2).
- 4. Cut on drawn line (Fig. 3).
- 5. Press seam towards the dark fabric (Fig 4.).
- 6. Square up each block to achieve 6" square blocks
- 7. Repeat for all squares until you have 80 blocks, each with one dark triangle and one light triangle.




Layout:
