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Cobblestone Quilt Pattern

Finished top size: including a 3-6" border: 50" x 60"

Borders:

Borders to make finished top approx 50" x 60".

Binding: 21/2" wide


Fabric Requirements & Cutting Instructions:

- Fifteen different coordinating fabrics, cut 4" strips by width of fabric (approx. 41"). Remove selvedges.
- Sew 5 strips together to produce 3 sets using a ¼" seam allowance.






- Stack the 3 sets one on top of the other. Trim ends to equal lengths.
- Using a cutting board and ruler cut sets at a 60-degree angle. Cut from top left edge at approximately 15 inches, down to the bottom at approximately 28 inches from left.
- Label each piece from each set as A1, A2, B1, B2, C1, C2.



- Arrange sets as shown in diagram. Sew sets together.
- When sewing angled pieces together, top and bottom edges may not match up. Place pins at seams to assist with the layout.
- Add border to make finished size approximately 50" x 60".
